CrissCross Edging by Patti Rosas

Materials List

Enough yarn to complete edging

Hook & Notions

Appropriate for yarn

Gauge

Varies depending on yarn weight used

Yarn needle



Rnd 1: With the B-side facing, use B-colored yarn and chain stitch around each post just below the B-colored edge, uniting the A & B sides together. Join with sl st in 1st ch st.

Rnd 2: On the B-side only, ch 3, dc around the edge working in the chain stitch loops, 3 dc in each corner stitch. Fasten off.

On the A-side only, join B-colored yarn, ch 3, dc around the edge working in the chain stitch loop, 3 dc in each corner stitch. Join with sl st in 3rd ch of 1st ch 3.

Rnd 3: With A-side facing, continue with B-colored yarn, sc around the edge, working through both loops of the A-side and B-side dc rows. Join with sl st in 1st sc.

Rnd 4: With B-colored yarn ch 8, sk 3 sc, sc in next sc, ch 8, drop B-colored yarn to back. Join A-colored yarn with sc in 2nd sc of sk 3, ch 8, sk 1 sc after B-colored sc, sc in next sc, ch 8, drop to back. Alternate B and A ch-8 loops with 1 sc between sc joins. End each color with sl st into 1st sc for that color. End off. Weave in ends.
